## The Waltham Walk

is a challenge expedition open to teams from any youth organisation, school, company or just a group of friends. Teams can be male, female or mixed. It's tough and challenging...but great fun!

Walk for one or two days using OS Explorer map 183 *Chelmsford & the Rodings*. The team's ability to navigate using map and compass is essential

- Take part in challenging 'incidents' involving streams, assault courses, and initiative tests
- Camp overnight and cook your own meals

There are many trophies to be competed for, including the famous WW Boot, cups and shields.

The entry fee covers administration costs, camp fees, and meal at the finish for those walking on Sunday, logbooks and certificates for all teams taking part

## The Main Event

Teams will start on Saturday at Rivenhall then walk 16 miles between checkpoints, carrying all equipment needed for the weekend. After camping overnight at Fairplay House Outdoor Centre, Wickham Bishops they will walk about 8 miles on Sunday to finish back at Rivenhall VH .

Age range: 14 – 18 inclusive.

## The Mini Trek

After 10 mile walk on Saturday, starting at Rivenhall VH, teams will camp overnight at Fairplay House Outdoor Centre, Wickham Bishops , then walk 8 miles on Sunday. Teams carry 'day sacks' only (tents etc, transported) and will finish at Rivenhall VH.

Age range: 12, 13, and 14.

## The Veterans/Supervets Events

Vets & Supervets teams will walk the whole Saturday route.. competing for the Saturday Veterans' Trophy. Supervets will camp and continue to finish at Rivenhall on Sunday.

Age: 19+ (no upper age limit !)
